Lord Sugar urged Prime Minister **Theresa May** to ignore the "nonsense" surrounding her during **Brexit** negotiations to reach an agreement.

Mrs May has been facing increasing pressure from Brexit Secretary David Davis over plans to allow a time-limited deal with the **European Union** which could come into force in the event of a no deal.

Writing an imaginary letter to the PM on **talkRADIO**, Lord Sugar said: "Dear Prime Minister, stick with it, just stick with it.

"Ignore all the nonsense because you cannot negotiate in an open arena."

The business magnate called on politicians and public alike to "leave her alone" as she discusses the terms of a new deal ahead of a crucial EU leaders meeting scheduled for June 22-23.

Lord Sugar continued: "There is obviously some very intricate negotiations going on behind the scenes and I quite understand why we don't get a day to day, blow by blow progress report on what's going on. You can't do that when you're negotiating, can you?"

"You can't do that when you are negotiating and I'm pretty sure, pretty confident, there are some very good negotiations going on behind the scenes."

He added: "Obviously no one can tell us what stage they are at because you weaken your position."

"When the time is right, and I'd be very disappointed if that is not the case, you will get it all laid out on a piece of paper and say 'here we are, half the deal is done.' Leave her alone at the moment, and her people and let her get on with it."

Mrs May's proposed arrangement would see the UK remaining 'closely tied to Brussels for an indeterminate period of time' at the end of the transition period in the hope a new customs arrangement would emerge as the answer for the Irish border question.

Avoiding the creation of a hard border on the island of Ireland has become the most divisive topic of Brexit, with the bloc refusing to agree to a new deal without the certainty of a frictionless border.

Secretary Davis is at the heart of the dispute due to his refusal to back down and demand a time-limited plan.
